Hello, family and friends of a Country Dale student!

The Cougar Chase is the Country Dale PTO's new fundraiser. Scheduled for **October 14**, this event is an opportunity for every student to show their school spirit and work on their physical fitness. Each student will run or walk laps in the field on a circuit designed by our own P. E. teacher, Mr. Blask. Prior to the big day, students will ask people to sponsor them per accomplished lap or a flat rate from family members and family friends. After the run, the students return to the family and friends with the number of laps they accomplished and collect the funds.

What does PTO do with the funds raised? 100% of the proceeds go back into the school for the benefit of the students in some way. Whether it be for fun events to build our school community or outfitting all classrooms with Smart Board technology (last year each classroom was outfitted with a Smart Board), we are looking to better our already fantastic school. This year we are looking to get more books in each classroom for the individual ability levels of each student.

This is our first time doing this event, so we are not totally sure how many laps an average student will run. Here is a ballpark estimate of the number of laps students in each grade might possibly accomplish in the allotted 20 minutes:

K-10 1st-12 2nd-13 3rd-14 4th-15 5th-18 6th - 20 8 laps = 1 mile

As always, participation in all of the PTO's fundraisers is voluntary. We specifically changed this Fall Fundraiser away from sales promotions with the hope that we would all see more value for the children with this type of event. **ALL** students will participate on the day regardless of whether or not they collect pledges.

RAIN DATES – In case of inclement weather on October 14th. The following Wednesdays of Oct. 19th and 26th will be our backup plans. Hopefully they will not be needed.
